

The Director asked the Board to amend the Hilgenhurst contract to include the costs of printing more than 25 copies. He explained to the Board that the reason why the cost is considerably higher than anticipated is the addition of the hand-folded maps which are cost

Motion: By Mr. McCarthy, seconded by Mr. Tulimieri, to execute the amendment to the Hilgenhurst contract to increase the number of copies to be provided from 25 to 500 and to increase the compensation in an amount equal to direct publication costs. Unanimous vote in favor.

The Director read a list of net increases of additional dwelling units that could be built in Arlington. Under the old zoning bylaw the total was 8,130 units, excluding the PUD district. Under the new zoning bylaw, there would be an additional 3,330 possible units and the population growth would be cut by about two-thirds.

Other Business

The Board discussed an additional amendment on swimming pools but decided not to add one.
